Specifications:

There are no limits to photos and copy on any single page.

Full Page Advertisement: 8 ½” x 11”

Half Page Advertisement: 8 ½” x 5 ½”

Stud Dog Directory: 2 ½” x 8” box with one image and copy including pedigree

Litter Box: 1” x 8” box with one image and copy including sire and dam

Handler Directory: 2 ½” x 8” box with one image and copy.

If Great Dane Gazette is building your advertisement:

We would love to build your ad for you. We enjoy creating fun and informative ads. We need your help to do a good job though. Below are some basic guidelines to follow when putting together your layout and materials.

1. Layout. Provide us with a basic idea of what you have in mind as a layout. The best way to do this is in a Word document but if that fails draw a layout on a piece of paper. Typed copy in an emailed document is much more precise and accurate allowing us to copy and paste your words. Reducing errors.
2. Photos. If you have scanned images we would like you to evaluate what you have before emailing. They should be full size (whatever size you expect them to be on the ad) and 300 dpi. We cannot emphasize to you the importance of a full size image for print media. The larger your image the better it will look on paper. We would prefer you send us the original photo so we can scan it on our commercial scanners and provide you with the best end result. All photos are returned to you after publication.
3. Remember that there is a limit to the amount of information that can be effectively presented on a 8 ½ x 11 inch piece of paper. If you need two pages don't be bashful.
4. If you have concerns or questions please contact glenn@greatdanegazette.com for help.

Once you get all of your materials to us we will build your ad and email a proof. You can make as many adjustments and changes as necessary. We want to communicate with you, we want to hear from you. In the end, if you are not happy the project was a failure.

Camera Ready Specifications:

Camera ready means that your ad requires that our staff spend no time on layout, copy, changes or design. When building your ad remember that printed media is much different than web. Your images must be much large and of much higher resolution. What looks good on a computer monitor may be very fuzzy and pixilated on a printed page. Your original photos should be scanned at full size and 300 dpi resolution. As a guide, when you are done with the ad it should be at least 20 megs in color or 7 megs if black and white. Use this as a guideline.

1. Trimmed page size is 8 ½” x 11”
2. If you provide a bleed please make your page size 8¾” x 11¼” and have the background overlap.
3. Keep all important images and copy within 8¼” x 10¾”. Items outside this area could be lost or trimmed at the printer. We like to call this area the “Safe Zone”.
4. Keep in mind that there is a 10% dot gain in printing and that dark images will print even darker. Reduce exposure to compensate. A black dog in a photo with shadows will need work!

Send us your ad in one of these two formats only

1. Native Photo Shop file un-flattened and fonts included. Preferred incase adjustments are required.
2. Flattened TIFF. If you are sure everything is perfect and our staff doesn't need to make adjustments.

2. Email: Only files less than 20 megs. Email to art@greatdanegazette.com
3. FTP: Use an FTP manager to upload your files to our server. This is the preferred way of transferring large files. The ftp address is mail.greatdanegazette.com . User name is gdupload and the password is fancyK9. Once you have uploaded your files please email glenn@greatdanegazette.com letting me know the files are on our server. I will let you know that everything has been received in good order.
